-Checklist of Ms. Melinda T. Quiñones, BAC Chairperson, Technical and discussed the following: Financial Documents **Technical Component envelope** b. Financial Component envelope B. Questions and Ms. Marisa R. Lo, BAC Vice-Chairperson, Answers clarified to the end user that this procurement activity covers 12 months of FY 2025, not the calendar year from January to December 2025. The end user confirmed this and noted that the installation will take approximately 30-45 days. Mr. Edmund He cited that the pages 26-28 of the bidding Dulay documents posted on PhilGEPS are missing. Globe The BAC Secretariat provided copies of these Telecom/Innove pages to the attendees and confirmed that they would be included in the upcoming supplemental bid bulletin (SBB). Question 1: He inquired about the additional tests referenced in the specification under Service Testing: "PCAF may request an additional test, subject to payment of charges set by the Service Provider." Reply: The BAC inquired with the end user whether additional tests were required beyond those specified in the bid documents. The end user clarified that no additional tests are needed. Since all required tests have already been outlined in the bidding documents, the end user confirmed that this clause would be removed from the specifications. **Question 2:** Can the requirement be reduced from six (6) to three (3) cable landing stations in the Philippines connecting internationally for diversity and redundancy? Reply: The BAC will consult the TWG and end user regarding the matter. If approved, it will be included in the SBB. The deadline for the clarifying and/or interpreting any part of the bidding documents is November 30, 2024.
