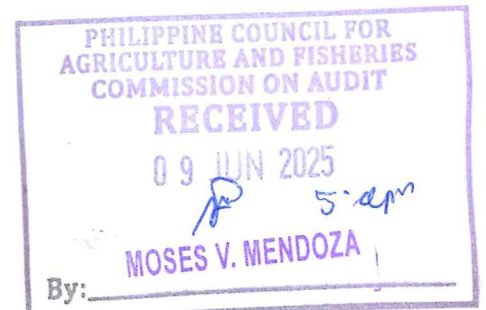


CONTRACT OF AGREEMENT



KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Contract of Agreement made and entered into this ____ day of ____ 2025 at Quezon City, Philippines by and between:

The **PHILIPPINE COUNCIL FOR AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES (PCAF)**, a government agency attached to the Department of Agriculture (DA), created pursuant to Executive Order No. 366, Series of 2004, with office address at the Apacible Hall, Department of Agriculture Compound, Elliptical Road, Diliman, Quezon City, represented in this Act by its **Executive Director III, BERNADETTE B. DE LOS SANTOS**, hereinafter referred to as the **PCAF**;

-and-

FILIPINIANA RESORTS DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION, a registered corporation duly organized under Philippine laws and licensed to operate business in the Philippines, with principal office address at Roxas Drive, Brgy. Sto. Niño, Calapan City, Oriental Mindoro, represented in this Act by its duly authorized representative, **EMMA B. DELA TORRE, Marketing Officer**, hereinafter referred to as the **SUPPLIER**.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, **PCAF** requested the procurement of One (1) Lot Function Hall with meals for the conduct of 2025 PAFC Oriental Mindoro meetings on May 29-30, August 14-15, and October 23-24, 2025, in Calapan City, Oriental Mindoro with approved PR No. 24-04-169;

WHEREAS, the **SUPPLIER** has represented and warranted itself as capable, competent and duly licensed provider of function hall and meals under the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth;

WHEREAS, **PCAF** has agreed to enter into a contract with the **SUPPLIER** for the engagement of its services through Negotiated Procurement under Small Value as an alternative mode of procurement pursuant to Section 53.9 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of the Republic Act No. 9184;

WHEREAS, the opening of bid was undertaken on 28 April 2025, and after due evaluation by the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), the **SUPPLIER** was declared as the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Quotation, thus, the BAC recommended to the HOPE to award the above-mentioned procurement to the **SUPPLIER**;

WHEREAS, **PCAF** issued the Notice of Award to the **SUPPLIER** on 28 April 2025;

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the foregoing premises, the parties have agreed to the following terms and conditions:

Section 1
SCOPE OF SERVICES



The **SUPPLIER** will provide function hall and meals for a total of **THIRTY (30) Participants** during the Consultation for PAFC Oriental Mindoro meetings for May 29-30, August 14-15, and October 23-24, 2025.

Section 2
CONTRACT PRICE

For and consideration of the SERVICES to be undertaken by the **SUPPLIER**, PCAF shall pay the **SUPPLIER** in Philippine Currency in accordance with the Contract the total amount of **ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-TWO THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED (Php 182,700.00)** inclusive of all applicable government taxes and fees for the whole duration of the event.



Section 3
RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE SUPPLIER

The **SUPPLIER** shall:

- 
1. Provide the necessary function hall and meals for a total of **THIRTY (30) Participants** during Consultation for PAFC Oriental Mindoro meetings for May 29-30, August 14-15, and October 23-24, 2025;
 2. Be held accountable for all liabilities resulting from damage to properties and lives attributed to the **SUPPLIER's** fault or negligence for the duration of this contract;
 3. Hold **PCAF** free from any third-party liability arising from damages to public and private properties, death, or injury to people as a result of any incident attributed to the **SUPPLIER's** fault that may have occurred during the performance of the contract.
 4. Ensure that all the services to be performed under or pursuant to this contract shall meet the same high standards as those offered by similar businesses of superior knowledge and skill, engaged in similar services under analogous circumstances;
 5. Book **PCAF** for a different date if the event is canceled due to unforeseen circumstances. The new schedule will be mutually agreed upon by both parties.

Section 4
RESPONSIBILITIES OF PCAF

The **PCAF** shall:

- 
1. Ensure that the **SUPPLIER** meets the required specifications on the day of the activity.
 2. Pay the **SUPPLIER** the guaranteed number of participants after completion of the activity and upon the receipt of the billing statement;
 3. Agree that the total amount of **ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-TWO THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED (Php 182,700.00)** inclusive of government taxes shall be billed progressively, with payment to be released to the supplier upon receipt of an invoice for each completed event;

4. Exercise strict discipline and ensure that personnel are closely supervised and managed in accordance with the law and policies set forth by the **SUPPLIER**.

Section 5 **TERMS OF PAYMENT**

The total contract price for the function hall and meals is **ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-TWO THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED (Php 182,700.00)** inclusive of all applicable government taxes and fees for the whole duration of the event.

Section 6 **INCLUSION IN THE SERVICES**

The **SUPPLIER** shall provide for the following:

- **Function Hall with meals**
Full Board Meals
Food @ 6 days @ 30pax
(May 29-30, August 14-15, and October 23-24, 2025)
Location: Calapan City, Oriental Mindoro
Date: May 29-30, August 14-15, and October 23-24, 2025

- **Inclusions:**

MEALS per day (Pack-Breakfast, AM Snacks, Lunch, PM Snacks, and Dinner)

- 1 meat viand (pork/chicken), 1 vegetable, 1 rice, and 1 drink
- Snacks with 1 drink
- Preferably serve locally produced products
- Seating capacity up to 33 pax for fish bone and/or round table set up, well-lighted, airconditioned, with good ventilation
- Free use of sound system
- Free use of electricity
- Free use of function hall

- **Payment terms: Progressive billing**
- **inclusive of government tax**

Section 7
USE OF SUPPLIER'S PARKING SPACE

The **SUPPLIER** shall allow the use of its parking space and other hotel amenities to the participants free of charge.

Section 8
TERMINATION OF CONTRACT

PCAF reserves the right to terminate this Contract for any substantial breach committed by the **SUPPLIER** and such breach is not corrected within a reasonable time upon demand, as warranted by the circumstances.

Section 9
VENUE OF ACTION

The parties shall make every effort to resolve amicably and by mutual consultation any or all disputes or differences arising between the Parties in connection with the implementation of this Contract. In case of litigation arising from or in connection with this contract, the parties agree that the venue of action shall be at the proper court in QUEZON CITY ONLY to the exclusion of other courts.

Section 10
CAPACITY AND AUTHORIZATION

Each party in this contract assures and warrants that it has the authority to sign and fulfill the agreement without violating any laws or existing agreements. Additionally, it confirms that the contract is legally binding and enforceable.

Section 11
LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

As provided in Section 68 of the revised IRR of RA 9184, the winning bidder shall pay liquidated damages in case of breach of contract. The amount of liquidated damages shall be at least equal to one-tenth of one percent (0.001) of the cost of the unperformed portion for every day of delay. Once the cumulative amount of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%) of the amount of contract, the Procuring Entity may rescind or terminate the contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies available under the circumstances.

Section 12
OTHER CONDITIONS OF THE CONTRACT

In case of damage or loss to the property of the participants of **PCAF** caused by negligence of the **SUPPLIER's** personnel or employee, the **SUPPLIER** shall be liable for the damages;

Necessary medical services and facilities shall be the responsibility and for the account of the **SUPPLIER**; and

The **SUPPLIER** shall exercise extraordinary diligence in the performance of its duties. Additionally, all services rendered under or pursuant to this contract shall adhere to the same high standards as those offered by comparable businesses with superior knowledge and skill operating under similar circumstances.

**Section 13
AMENDMENT**

All stipulations set forth in this Contract shall apply unconditionally, subject to amendments that may be mutually agreed by both parties in writing.


